WHAT MAKES TROPICAL NORTH QUEENSLANDS UNIQUE?

- This is the only place on the planet where two World Heritage areas – the Great Barrier Reef and Wet Tropics Rainforest – sit side by side.
- The weather is always warm with the average year-round temperature nudging 29C.
- Dozens of tours depart every day for the reef, rainforest, tropical islands and the outback.
- The region is famous for food with an abundance of ingredients grown right here.
- It's easy to see wildlife while exploring the reef, visiting a conservation park or driving a bush road.
- We sit at one end of a 3700km trail that crosses the continent.
- There's an abundance of freshwater streams perfect for swimming.
- Palm trees, golden sunrises and long stretches of sand.
- There are more than 8000 accommodation rooms in Cairns.
- The airport is an easy 15-minute drive from the heart of the city.
- Cairns is a compact city that's made for walking, wandering, strolling and sauntering.
- Tropical North Queensland is home to the world's longest lava tubes, the state's two tallest mountains, Australia's largest moth, the planet's biggest fern and one impossibly blue butterfly.
- Visitors can have breakfast beside the Coral Sea, lunch on a dairy farm high in the hills, and dinner in the rainforest.
