

SAFETY FEATURES OF THE HOTEL

LOCATION AND CONTEXT

Shangri-La Rasa Sentosa, Singapore is situated on the beachfront of Sentosa Island and conveniently linked to mainland Singapore by a causeway. The resort is approximately 30 kilometres from Changi Airport and easily accessible by the emergency services if required.

GUEST SAFETY AND SECURITY

Shangri-La Hotels and Resorts would like to assure every guest of its commitment to their personal safety and security.

FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY

The resort is equipped with a comprehensive Fire & Life safety system which includes the automatic fire detection and alarm system, fire protection system together with emergency response procedures.

The automatic fire detection and alarm system consists of addressable smoke detectors and monitoring devices installed in guestrooms and throughout the resort that are connected to the main fire alarm panel in the Fire Command Centre. Staff in the Fire Command Centre will respond immediately to the activation of any device. The fire protection system includes automatic sprinklers together with fire hydrants and hose reels installed throughout the resort. These systems are approved by the Fire Department and regularly tested by our Fire & Life Safety Manager to an approved programme.

The resort has an established, comprehensive Emergency Response Plan which includes the Emergency Response Team (ERT) and emergency management procedures. The ERT is on standby 24 hours daily led by the Duty Manager and supported by the resort's Security and Engineering staff. All ERT members are fully trained in fire-fighting procedures, first aid and incident handling. Fire Drills are conducted frequently to an approved programme. In addition a full evacuation drill is conducted twice yearly with the participation of all resort staff.

SECURITY

The resort has its own well-trained and experienced security team who maintain a close relationship with the local emergency services. These officers are backed by a manned security control room which has 24 hours CCTV coverage of the resort and a comprehensive alarm and access control system.

All security personnel across the Group operate on a standard set of response options covering a wide range of critical and emergency situations.

WATER

Water supplied through the municipal supply network is filtered, disinfected and treated before storage in regularly cleaned tanks. In addition, water from the tanks passes through a final stage of Ultra Violet disinfection treatment before distribution throughout the resort. The distributed water complies with the World Health Organization standards for potable water. The resort has at anytime a 1 day storage supply of potable water.

FOOD SAFETY

The resort maintains internationally recognised standards of food hygiene and sanitation. In 2001, the Group introduced the Shangri-La Food Safety Management System (SFSMS) to ensure the highest level of standards in food sanitation across all hotels in the Group. The industry leading SFSMS is based upon principles of the system used in food manufacturing often referred to as Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP). All steps in the food operation are addressed from the supply chain and selection of ingredients through to the serving of the food to the customer. The resort has a food hygienist on staff to ensure food safety hygiene standards are monitored and kept up to date, and resorts are audited yearly to verify implementation and compliance with SFSM policies.

Shangri-La Rasa Sentosa, Singapore is a SG Clean certified establishment and is one of the first hotels in Singapore to be awarded the SafeGuard Hygiene Excellence and Safety Label by Bureau Veritas. Our Shangri-La Cares commitment and highly vaccinated workforce provides the safest possible environment for your next stay with us.

FUEL AND POWER

In the unlikely event of disruption to the electricity supply, the resort's emergency generator will automatically operate, to ensure that all fire & life safety and essential equipment will continue to operate.

ELECTRICITY

Electricity supply within the resort is available 24 hours and supplied at 230 Volts 50 Hertz in the guestrooms.

SWIMMING POOL SAFETY

Fully trained lifeguards are on duty at all times during swimming pool opening hours.
