

## Safety Features of the Hotel

### WATER

The potable water in the Hotel is dual-fed from the City supply into six potable water tanks, totalling a capacity of 70,000 litres. In addition, to ensure that the fire services system is prepared for any emergencies, the dual-fed water supplies two 36,000-litre fire hydrant and hose reel water tanks, as well as one 125,000-litre sprinkler water tank.

### FOOD

In the face of environmental considerations and to keep ahead of hygiene and sanitation requirements, Island Shangri-La, Hong Kong has a full-time food safety and hygiene specialist, to ensure that the food safety / hygiene standards are continuously monitored and kept up to date.

### FUEL AND POWER

The Hotel has an Emergency Generator set, providing output power of 850 KVA. The Emergency Generator set can run continuously for 26 hours before re-fuelling is needed.

### FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY

The Hotel is equipped with an Automatic Sprinkler Protection System, together with Fire Hydrants, Hose Reels, Smoke Extraction Systems and Smoke Masks in all guestrooms. An Automatic Fire Alarm System is installed in all Mechanical and Electrical (M&E) areas, all guest floors and public areas. The Hotel has positive pressurisation staircases and fire roller shutters for all guest and public floors.

The Hotel's Fire Fighting Team includes all

Engineering staff, Assistant Duty Managers, Security Officers, Housekeeping Supervisors and Outlet Managers, who have been trained by the Local Fire Services Department. The Hong Kong Fire Service Brigade has been trained to reach the Hotel within six minutes after receiving notice, either from the Hotel by telephone or from the Automatic Fire Alarm System.

The Hotel's Fire Fighting Team conducts fire drills three times a month. For all hotel staff, a quarterly fire and evacuation drill is held.

### SECURITY

The Hotel is in close proximity to the Hong Kong Police Force Headquarters (within a distance of one kilometre).

The Hotel has its own well-trained and experienced Security Team and ensures professional personnel, who have long standing experience in crime prevention, as well as good relationships with the local government and police authorities, head the team.

The Hotel's premises are monitored by a CCTV system and patrolled by its Security Officers 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

All Security Officers are trained in VIP protection and safety measures, as well as customer hospitality.
