

2 months old Sudharshanan A/L Anandkumar has been diagnosed with Total Anomalous Pulmonary Venous Drainage (TAPVD), where the blood flow returning from the lungs is draining abnormally. He needs to undergo surgery (repair of TAPVD) to correct the anomalous drainage of blood flow returning from the lungs. The estimated cost of the surgery is between RM80.000 to RM90.000.





4 years old Mohamad Aidil Zahwandi Herliady Bin Abdullah has been diagnosed with a heart condition identified as Moderate DCSA Ventricular Septal Defect with Mild Atrial Regurgitation. He requires to undergo surgery, ventricular septal defect closure. He is currently at home in Sabah waiting for surgery. The estimated cost for his treatment is RM80.000.

1 year old Qilla Zhafirah Binti Mohd Jamil has Down syndrome and a heart condition identifies as Moderate Secundum Atrial Septal Defect with a small Patent Ductus Arteriosus in failure. Her prescribed treatment includes PO Frusemide 6mg BO and PO Captopril 2mg BO and need to undergo Atrial septal defect closure and patent ductus arteriosus ligation, with an estimated cost for the surgery being RM80,000. She is currently in Tawau Sabah waiting for treatment.
